Dear Bill:

I got your letter when I returned to my home in New York ten days ago. I had just returned from Los Angeles where, had I known that you were trying to get hold of me, I would have seen you. I attended Dr. Hargis's Convention at the Biltmore, and left L.A. the afternoon before the riots began. I am now ensconced in Belmont as an editor.

The best book of photos of the FLN atrocities is known as the "Green Book." I know one man in New York who has a copy, and I know that Robert Welch has a copy. I would imagine that a copy exists somewhere in the files of the San Marino office of the JBS. I'll bet that Mary Jane Blackwell can help you, since she has long been a subscriber to my publication and was interested in the Algerian business. If she cannot locate you a copy of the GREEN BOOK, then I shall write my friend in New York and see if he can help. You'll have to take photographs of the book pages. However, there may be some glossies somewhere in the file cabinets of UPI or AP, but I wouldn't bet on it. I know that the Enquirer once printed a full center fold of photos of the massacre in Algiers of the Europeans who had paraded in defense of French Algeria and were machine-gunned by Gaullist troops. But they may not be the kind of pictures you want. The Green Book has the most grisly pictures you can imagine, enough to really shock an audience off their seats.

Let me know how you make out, and I shall see what I can do if you can't get the material in San Marino.
