Dr. Hess, a practicing physician in Bunker Hill, Illinois, is a graduate of Illinois College and Washington University School of Medicine. He is nationally known in medical circles because of his work in exposing the dangers inherent in socialized medicine (i.e., Medicare). A past president of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons, he presently serves on its Board of Directors.

After years of serious study of the theory and practice of Communism, Dr. Hess became convinced of his personal obligation to expose the nature of the basic conflict between Communism and Christianity. In his talks he peppers his own personal views with illustrations drawn from his many and extensive trips abroad—on both sides of the Iron Curtain.

During 1965 he made fact-finding trips to India, Thailand, Viet Nam, Hong Kong, Formosa, and Japan in Asia and to divided Berlin, as well as other cities in Europe.
