## Is Netanyahu the Free World's New Ronald Reagan?

Many of them would gladly live under a democratic Palestinian state which would offer them the full rights of citizenship.

But from what we can gather, Palestine is going to be an exclusively Islamic entity which will exclude Jews and be supported by the American taxpayer, thanks to President Obama's generosity.

And the only world statesman who has emerged out of all of this as a defender of conservative Judeo-Christian values is Netanyahu, who sounds more like Ronald Reagan than any other Western statesman. He favors free-market economics, a democratic form of government in which freedom of speech and religion are upheld, and a strong defense of Western values.
