PROGRESS REPORT

LANGUAGE ARTS

READING: Peter has completed the Scholastic "Action" series, as well as two novellas from the "Pacemaker" series. Peter's comprehension, especially recall of important facts, improved quite a bit this term. Peter seemed to enjoy the reading series. His decoding skills still need fleshing out, but he has improved. There are occasional reversals, but certainly not as often as in the beginning of the year. Good effort.

LANGUAGE: Peter has mastered most basic phonics concepts. He should continue class work with prefixes and suffixes, as well as parts of speech as additions to Peter's decoding skills. Also, Peter should pursue study of parts of speech and tense changes.

MATHEMATICS

Peter has done excellent work in math this term. He has mastered all arithmetic operations with fractions, including mixed numbers, reducing to lowest terms, and finding common denominators. I would suggest that Peter review fractions, work with decimals and percentages, and apply these skills to money and measurement exercises. Very good work.

GEOGRAPHY - SOCIAL STUDIES

Peter worked in the Scholastic "Map Skills" series and completed book C.

Peter mastered scaling, reading simple maps and recognizing topographical

features. His geography study was very good and Peter seemed to profit by it.
