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Dear Gary,

Dick Jones has urged me to get in touch with you and offer some of my books for publication and distribution by your ministry. He believes that I can substantially expand the reach of American Vision by helping it appeal to the great Christian homeschool movement of which I have been a very strong promoter. Over the last 20 years I have spoken at many homeschool conventions in the U.S. as well as in Canada, Australia, and New Zealand.

My strong phonetic reading program, *Alpha-Phonics*, has been used by thousands of homeschoolers to teach their children to become highly competent readers, capable of reading the Bible as well as Shakespeare, Dickens, and our great American classics. High literacy is one of the great achievements of the homeschool movement. Meanwhile, the rest of American children, including many Christian children, who attend our public schools have become the victims of a cruel and vicious agenda to dumb them down and destroy their brains.

In my book, *NEA: Trojan Horse in American Education*, I described how this conspiracy against literacy was engineered by progressive educators, led by John Dewey, determined to turn America into a socialist society governed by atheist behavioral psychologists and scientists. That book is now out of print, but it can be republished with a new Introduction by yourself and a new final chapter to bring the story up to date.

Also, my seminal book on how the government got involved in education, *Is Public Education Necessary?* can now be reissued with a new Introduction by yourself. The book is considered a classic, and I keep getting requests for it. Unfortunately, it is out of print. Both these books were instrumental in getting many parents to remove their children from the public schools.

Another book that would enhance American Vision's reach into the homeschool movement is *How to Tutor*, a book that tells parents how to teach the 3Rs at home in the traditional manner. Many homeschoolers got started with this book. It was first published in 1973 and is now ready for updating.

Other books of mine you might consider for the American Vision program are: *The New Illiterates and How to Prevent Your Child from Becoming One.* *The Whole-Language/OBE Fraud.* *Homeschooling: A Parents Guide to Teaching Children.* My books have been used at Christian colleges to educate future teachers, and I am well known among the major activists in Christian education. In addition, I write columns for *Practical Homeschooling* and *WorldNetDaily*, and for many years was on the staff of Chalcedon.

I also have a number of ideas for new books: *How to Prevent Reading Failure.* *A Short Uncensored History of American Education.* *The Making of the Black Underclass.* *How to Raise a Literate Child.* *How to Raise a Virtuous Daughter.* *God and Man at Harvard.* *Cursive First: A Primer in Cursive Writing.* *A Curriculum Guide for Christian Teachers.*

If you find any of the above of interest, I will be more than happy to work with you in expanding your reach into the homeschool movement. I believe that the future of our country depends largely on how strong and vital the homeschool movement continues to grow and prosper in our society and attract more Christian families to its numbers. That's where religion can be taught in freedom, unhampered by government and the ACLU, and where literacy can be enhanced among Christian families that increasingly will form the social backbone of our nation. The fact that Christian homeschoolers tend to have large families is a demographic development in our favor.

In short, the new homeschooled generation needs all the support and guidance it can get from those of us who have done all in our power to wean Christians away from the atheist-humanist government schools.
